SKELETAL MUSCLE STRUCTURE Connective Tissue Components The highly specialized skeletal muscle cells, or muscle fibers, are covered by a delicate connective tissue membrane called the endomysium (Figure 10-1). Groups of skeletal muscle fibers, called fascicles, are then bound together by a tougher connective tissue envelope called the perimysium.
